A number of exciting musical opportunities are available to elementary students in Irvine Unified School District. Our block music program is recognized as one of the strongest in the state. All students in grades 4-6 participate in music **without missing other classroom instruction**. All 4th, 5th, and 6th grade students receive two 40-minute music instruction periods each week provided by a team of music educators.



All vocal and instrumental classes receive academic and effort grades. **There is homework and home practice involved in all programs.** All music students learn performance skills, music theory, and music literacy, and are required to participate in one evening concert in the spring.

Students who already play a wind or string instrument are encouraged to continue doing so in Advanced Strings or Advanced Winds.
