#### ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE INDEX (API) ADEQUATE YEARLY PROGRESS (AYP)

The Academic Performance Index (API) is a numeric index or scale that ranges from a low of 200 to a high of 1000. The state set 800 as the interim API score that schools should strive to meet. Schools that fall short of 800 are required to meet annual growth targets until their goal is achieved. Schools that already meet or exceed the 800 API should continue working to improve the academic performance of all students.

Adequate Yearly Progress is a federal measure based on student participation rates in testing and scores on the California Standards Tests, and the school's API. If a school does not meet its goals in any one of these areas, it has not made AYP overall.

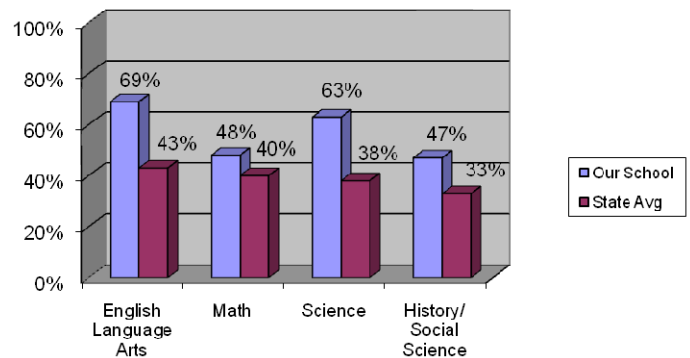
#### DROPOUT AND GRADUATION RATE, 2006

The formula for the one-year dropout rate is (grade 9 through 12 dropouts divided by grades 9 through 12 enrollment) multiplied by 100. The graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of high school graduates by the sum of dropouts for grades 9 through 12, in consecutive years, plus the number of graduates.

#### CALIFORNIA STANDARDS TEST, 2007

The California Standards Tests (CST) show how well students are doing in relation to the state content standards. Student scores are reported as performance levels. The graph below shows the percent of students at our school achieving at the proficient or advanced level in reading and math compared to the results at the district and state levels.



#### SAT I REASONING TEST

Students may voluntarily take the SAT test for college entrance. Students may take the test more than once, but only the highest score is reported at the year of graduation. The table shows how well our 12<sup>th</sup> grade students did on the SAT I Reasoning test compared to that of the district and state's average.
