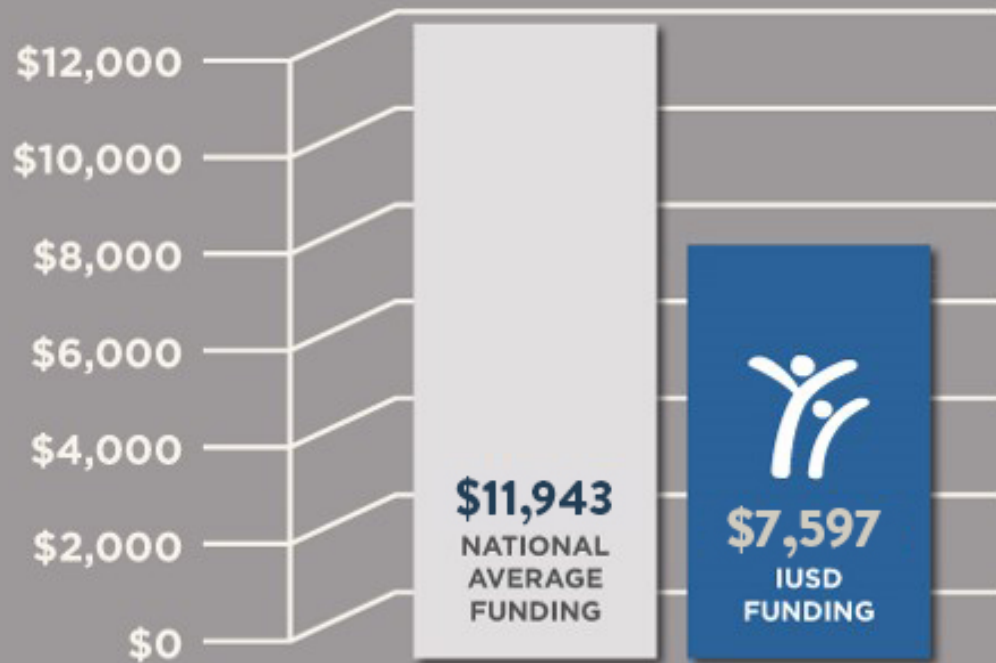

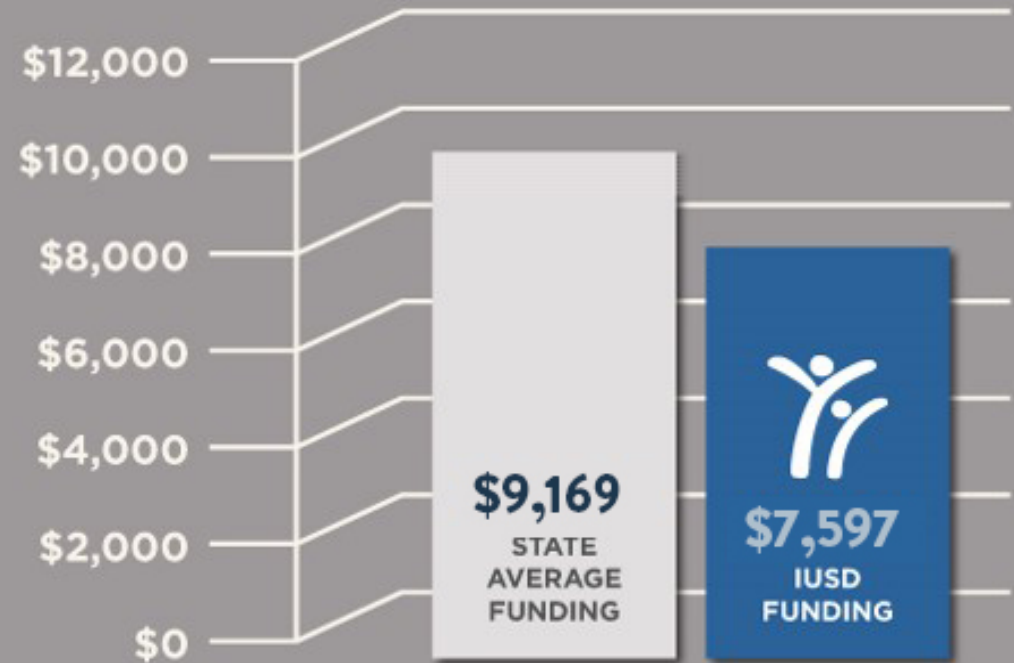
NATIONAL & STATE PER PUPIL FUNDING COMPARISON

STATE AVERAGE FUNDING GAP

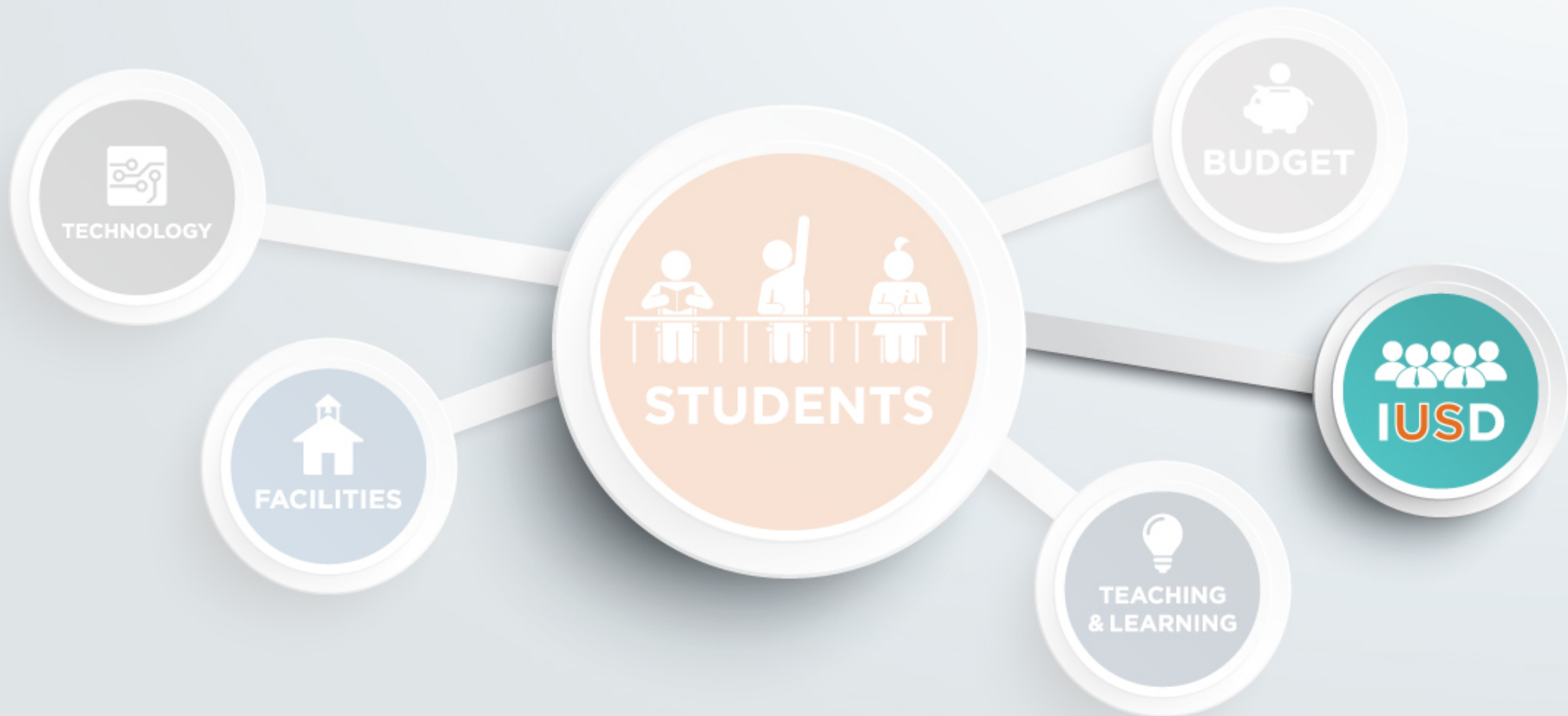


IMPACT: IUSD LOSES \$54 MILLION PER YEAR
