Finance Committee Business

1. Call to Order; Roll Call

a. Member Scott Hansen called the meeting to order at 6:36 p.m.

2. Approval of the January 23, 2017 Meeting Minutes

 Member Cyril Yu moved with Member Sherry Slunka seconding approval of the January 23, 2017 meeting minutes, as presented.

3. Measure E Bond Update

- a. Kelvin Okino, Executive Director of Facilities Planning and Construction
 - i. Kelvin presented an overview of Bond Measure E
 - 1. \$319M passed June 7, 2016, spread over possible 4 issuances, first issuance was \$95M
 - 2. Measure E will impact 28 schools
 - ii. Projects prioritized based on: safety and security, age, impact the greatest number of students, and upgrading/new science labs at middle schools
 - 1. Design and construction process can take up to two to three years and includes site analysis, design, agency approvals, bidding and construction
 - iii. Series 1 will impact 21 schools
 - 1. Enclosing classrooms
 - 2. Modernizing facilities
 - 3. New/upgrades to music and science classrooms
 - 4. New theater
 - 5. New synthetic track field
 - iv. District will have "Measure E" website for additional information

4. Second Interim Budget Report Presentation

- a. John Fogarty, Assistant Superintendent of Business Services
 - i. District's second official revision with actual financial data through January 31, 2017
 - ii. Second interim includes assumptions based on the Governor's 17-18 budget proposal
 - 1. State revenues are lower than originally projected, hence 17-18 budget has been reduced from original projections done at First Interim
 - a. Includes COLA of 1.48%
 - b. Includes one-time funding of \$48/ADA approximately \$1.5M for IUSD
 - 2. LAO believes Governor's budget projections are very conservative
 - iii. LCFF Funding increase from 16-17 to 17-18 is \$12M
 - Growth positions, STRS/PERS cost increases/Special Ed increases and Step/Column account for nearly all of the \$12M

- iv. IUSD 16-17 includes planned deficit spending of one-time dollars. The one-time dollars are removed from out years and in 18-19 there is no deficit spending
- v. District Certified Positive
