Superintendent Walker commenced his report by noting that the District's Differentiation and Advanced Learning and Literacy departments collaborated to create monthly newsletters with resources for teachers, which are also available on the District website under parent engagement. This month's newsletter has information pertaining to Black History Month. In recognition of National School Counseling week, he extended his appreciation and recognition of the impact school counselors have on IUSD families. IUSD's Sierra Vista Middle School's Science Olympiad team hosted an invitational, in which 76 elementary and middle school teams from California and Texas, including 28 teams from IUSD participated. University High School students earned first place in the Science Bowl Regional competition; their fifth win in six years. The team will represent IUSD at the National Competition in April. In closing, the planning of the next round of WellSpaces is underway. This partnership is made possible with thanks to the Tsao Foundation, Children's Hospital of Orange County, the Orange County Department of Education and he thanked IUSD leadership staff Tammy Blakey and Sunny Shen and the IUSD Facilities team for their efforts in coordinating the creation of the WellSpaces.
