Kent Price provided a summary of the findings of the community survey conducted to ascertain the feasibility of a parcel tax. Price said that 400 Irvine residents were called, and the survey reflects the attitude of the larger voting population. The indications are that, with an aggressive campaign, the community

could support a \$35-\$40 parcel tax where the revenues would be used in support of science programs, library programs, and programs for teachers to improve their classroom skills. The costs of such a campaign would range from 40 to 60 thousand dollars. District funds cannot be used for this purpose, so funding would need to be derived from outside sources.

The Board requested the issue of Parcel Tax be agendized January 29, for discussion and action.
