**Coordination of Youth Services in Irvine**

The Board and the Council discussed the possibility of developing a plan to better integrate services provided to Irvine youth. Appreciation was expressed for the current working relationship between the two agencies on such issues as earthquake preparedness, before and after school child care, Kids Club programs, after school tutorials, driver education, facility use, and participation of the police department in Operation Safe Campus. Hadley commended the City for its multiservice center programs such as For Families, saying that those programs will become even more important as the District looks at budget reductions.

A discussion ensued on the idea of organizing a conflict resolution team for problems that arise periodically, the possible addition of another Council Member for the City Liaison Meetings, and examining the capabilities and cost of maintaining existing programs. No action was taken.

**Providing Opportunities to Increase Student Awareness of the Role of Municipal Government.**

Kay McNally outlined a proposal to have students from each of the three high schools serve as non-voting members on community services commissions. These students would participate on a rotating basis to maximize the numbers of students exposed to City government. The Board was in full support of the concept. IUSD staff will work on selecting students and coordinating a rotation schedule.

**AQMD Reg. 15**

Paul Reed provided an update on the implementation plans for compliance with Air Quality Management District requirements. The City Council expressed interest in seeing the incentive program -- a copy will be provided.

**Status of Windrow Community Park Construction**

Reed reported that the construction of the park is underway and should be ready for use in the Spring, 1992.

**IUSD/City of Irvine Joint Use Agreement**

Reed explained that the agreement was currently being reassessed, ways of expanding the relationship between the City and IUSD are being examined. The current agreement has been extended by mutual consent and the new agreement may be finalized and presented by the end of the year.

City Council members expressed interest in adding IUSD landscaping under their umbrella. The cost of sub-contracting with the City, and contractual obligations will be examined by IUSD staff.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
