Items of Business

Public Hearing: Recreation Improvement and Maintenance District (RIMD)

President Kuwabara reconvened the Public Hearing, continued from May 6, 2003, for the sole purpose of continuing the tabulation of the assessment ballots for the RIMD.

On the motion of Member McInerney, seconded by Member Coven and carried 3-0 (Members Choi and Kuwabara absent), the Board, upon the completion of the tabulation of assessment ballots, closed the Public Hearing on the RIMD

Assessment amount in favor of the RIMD: \$1,025,514.70 (63.93%)
Assessment amount in opposition to the RIMD: \$578,564.16 (36.07%)
