Member Burnham encouraged community members to read the October 18 L.A. Times Article "More than a Game."

Burnham thanked the City for the Harvest Cup, which provided a great opportunity for school aged students and families to enjoy a special day of lots of fun. Winners were the Meadow Park girls and the Bonita Canyon boys.

Steve McArthur attended the budget hearings provided by Paul Reed, designed to both inform the community on IUSD revenues and expenditures and allow for questions and community input. McArthur thanked Reed for the revenue presentations made and informed the community of the upcoming expenditure presentations.

Member Hadley announced the CAC meeting being held on Monday, October 24, for parents of children with special needs. Hadley encouraged participation in these very informative meetings.

Hadley also mentioned her opportunity to assist with and attend the OCSBA dinner Wednesday, October 19, which will also be a candidates forum for Maureen DiMarco and Delaine Eastin.

Hadley shared a report from Children's Hospital of Orange County, highlighting the sections on public education, teens, safety, and growing up hungry -- an excellent report card on children in Orange County.
