Dr. Shawna Stewart is the Director of Choral Studies at Biola University, where she conducts the Chorale and Vocal Jazz Ensemble while teaching conducting and choral methods. She holds degrees from the Eastman School of Music and the University of Southern California.

Under her direction, the Biola University Chorale has performed at multiple ACDA (American Choral Directors Association) Western Division Conferences, the 2025 National Convention, and several NCCO (New Century Chamber Orchestra) conferences. A highly sought-after clinician and adjudicator, Dr. Stewart has served on the California ACDA state board and the national advisory board for NCCO. In addition to her collegiate work, she is the owner of Children's Music Academy in Whittier, reflecting her dedication to early childhood music education.

Irvine Unified alumnus Jotaro Nakano is a Japanese American conductor currently serving as Music Director for the Longwood Symphony Orchestra and the SA'Oaxaca Strings International Music Festival.
