Family Solutions Collaborative (FSC)	2-1-1	211 connects residents in need to critical social services in Orange County such as housing, job placement, food, health insurance, community-based programs, community clinics, dental care, immunizations, prescription assistance, homeless shelters, elder and child care, legal services, and other resources offered by local nonprofits and government agencies such as Family Shelter System, Domestic Violence Service Integration, Bed Reservation System, and more.
Families and Communities Together (FaCT)	(714) 566-2878	FaCT is a network of Family Resource Centers throughout Orange County. The closest FRC for Irvine families would be Lake Forest or Tustin. Services are provided in English and Spanish.

Families Forward	(949) 552-2727	Provides access to housing, food assistance, career coaching, mental health counseling, financial literacy education, and other resources.
South County Outreach	(949) 380-8144	Serves homeless families, the underemployed, unemployed, seniors, veterans, and other at-risk residents of Orange County. South County Outreach provides the following services: housing programs, rental and utility assistance, and a food program.
CalOptima Health	(888) 587-8088	Provides health insurance plans for low-income children, adults, seniors and people with disabilities in Orange County.
CalFresh	(800) 281-9799	The CalFresh Program helps to improve the health and well-being of qualified households and individuals by providing them a means to meet their nutritional needs by issuing monthly electronic benefits that can be used to buy most foods at many markets and food stores.
Families Together	(800) 597-7977	Provides solutions for uninsured individuals and those with services not covered by insurance such as medical, dental, vision, behavioral health, pediatrics, women's health, dermatology, and more.
