McKinney-Vento Homeless Educational Rights and Services

The federal McKinney-Vento and California state law removes all educational barriers faced by children and youth without a fixed, regular, and/or adequate nighttime stay.

YOUR RIGHTS

ALL eligible McKinney-Vento students, regardless of legal documentation, immigration status, or presence of parent have the right to:

- Immediate enrollment and full participation in school, including preschool, after-school activities, and extracurricular activities.
- Finish the school year in the school where they start, even once housed.
- Unaccompanied youth may enroll in school immediately, and receive credit for schoolwork complete elsewhere.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility is determined by your nighttime stay. Children and youth qualify if they are:

- Sharing another family's house or apartment temporarily due to a loss of housing stemming from financial problems (e.g. loss of job, eviction, or natural disaster), and would otherwise be homeless.
- In an emergency shelter or transitional housing program.
- In a motel or hotel due to economic hardship and not by choice.
- In an abandoned building, unconverted garage, sleeping in a car, or on the streets.

HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Gather all school documents you have.
2. Check the IUSD website to determine which school is serving your area.
3. If you are new to IUSD, complete online enrollment, including the housing questionnaire, through IUSD.org.
