How could AI help with my learning?

AI tools can be used for brainstorming ideas and generating potential topics.

AI can assist in gathering research and summarizing topics.

AI can provide clarification for a complex text or additional information to support learning.

AI can provide support for specific skills, (learning vocabulary or new concepts).

AI can help me create content like images, graphics, audio and visuals.

AI tools can give feedback on grammar, spelling, and sentence structure.

I will still develop my own ideas and complete the assignment independently.

I can synthesize the information and present it in my own words.

I use AI supports to develop my own knowledge, skills, and understanding.

I can show how I understand a concept or skill and do it on my own.

I use my thinking to prompt AI and edit the work to make sure it reflects my ideas.

I use feedback from AI to help me revise or improve my writing.
