**Mandatory Job Walk**. A mandatory job walk will be conducted to answer any questions and explain details regarding proposal requirements, specifications, and scope of work. Effective April 1, 2015, all contractors and subcontractors must be registered with the DIR to submit a proposal for a public works project pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

The California Department of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for the locality in which the work is to be performed for the Project. Copies of these wage rate determinations, entitled Prevailing Wage Scale, are maintained at the DISTRICT office and are available at the following website: www.dir.ca.gov. It shall be mandatory upon the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor listed, to pay not less than the said specified rates to all workers employed by them for the Project.

No bidder may withdraw any proposal for a period of  $\underline{sixty}$  (<u>60</u>) calendar days after the date set for the opening of proposals.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, the Agreement will contain provisions permitting the successful proposer to substitute securities for any monies withheld by the DISTRICT to ensure performance under the Agreement or permitting payment of retentions earned directly into escrow.
