### Proposed Project List

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#### Modernize Facilities Over 25 Years of Age

Modernization includes the following work, as required and as funding is available.

##### Code Upgrades:

- Accessibility requirements, path-of-travel, restrooms, casework, signage.
- New fire alarm system and devices.
- Energy and water conservation, new light fixtures and controls, new plumbing fixtures, building envelope upgrades e.g. insulation and window systems.

##### Building System Upgrades:

- Main electrical service upgrade.
- New heating and air conditioning (HVAC) system, duct work and controls.
- New security system, door access control.
- Re-roofing, as required for HVAC upgrades.

##### Functional Improvements:

- New furniture.
- New classroom audio/visual systems.
- Creation of flexible collaborative spaces near classrooms.
- Reconfiguration of some spaces to support the program functional needs.
- New or refurbished casework.
- New flooring, ceiling and wall finishes.
- New equipment for kitchen.

##### Other Improvements:

- Upgrade Administration Areas.
- Modernize Media Center, Innovation Lab.
- Create space for Student Support Services and Special Education Programs.
- Interim housing during modernization work.



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#### Enclose Open Classrooms

Construct interior doors on existing classrooms:

- Modify heating and air conditioning.

Construct a new building to include:

- Three (3) music classrooms.
- Instrument storage.

# Timeframe for the Move

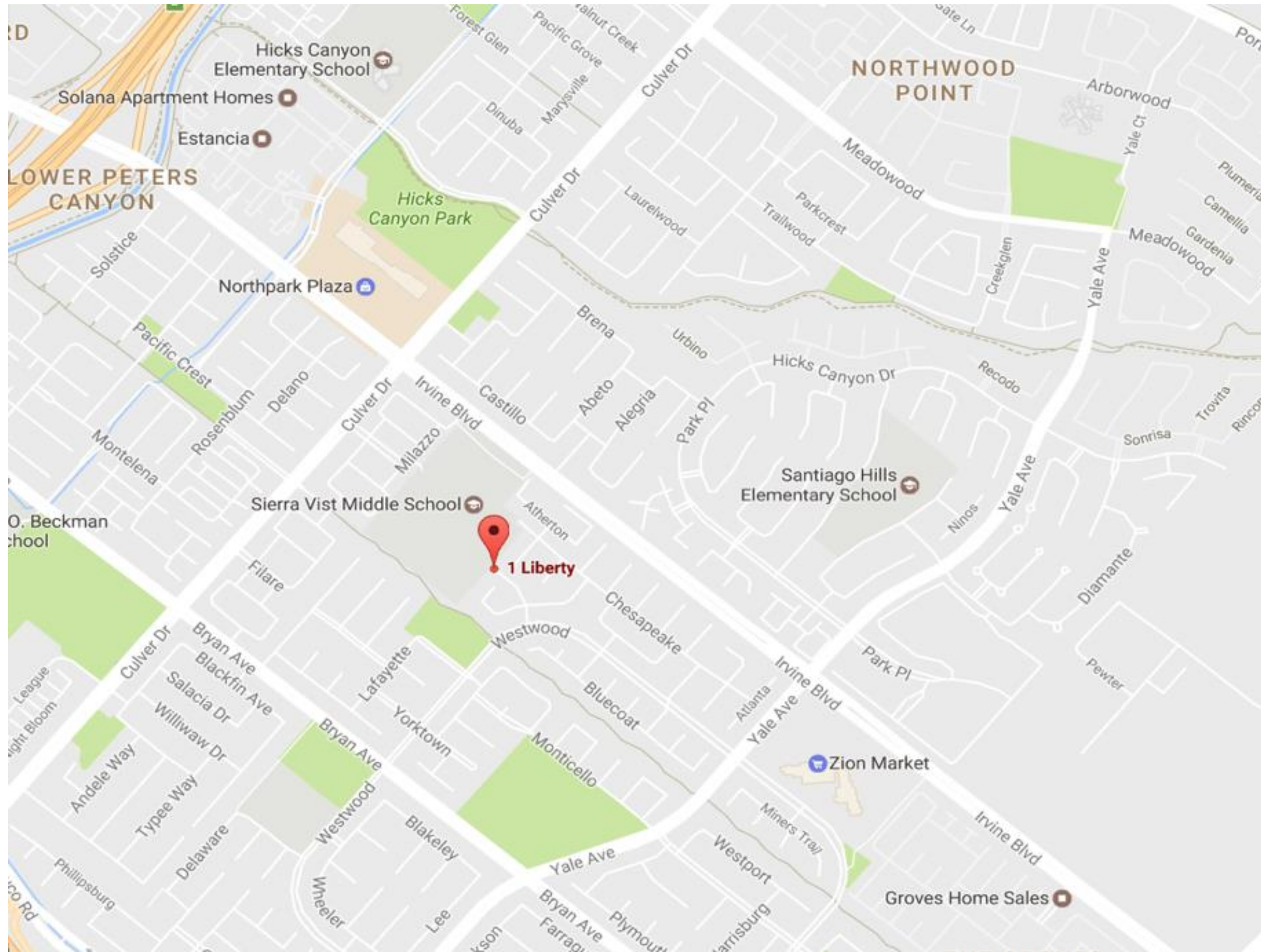
- Summer 2018 - Teachers and the school will move to Westwood Basics
- August 2018 - Brywood students will attend school at Westwood Basics (2018-2019 school year)
- Summer 2019 - Teachers and school will move back into Brywood
- August 2019 - Students will return to Brywood campus
