General Condition & Aesthetics

•Small campus size; limits ability to host large events and limits ability to expand facilities (e.g., to accommodate larger theater, additional indoor spaces) Aesthetically, described negatively as place designed to be a shopping center •New aquatic center will add to sense of pride students and community have for school

 Wireless infrastructure growing; will need to grow further to support expanding student population •Need to become dual platform to allow student access to up-to-date software in classes

•Designated computer labs exist, but insufficient for student population; need for additional labs and in-class computers •In-class computers exist for Special Ed department

Vehicular Access/ Parking/ Drop-Off

•Inadequate amount of parking •Cannot accommodate current student population; was designed for a 1000student population, no longer the case •New parking lot near new aquatic center will hopefully alleviate issues with students walking through parking lot across traffic areas


