During the Irvine Unified School District Board of Education Meeting on Tuesday, September 13, the Board voted on and unanimously passed two Measure E motions; the appointment of the Citizens Oversight Committee members and the issuance of the first bond series. 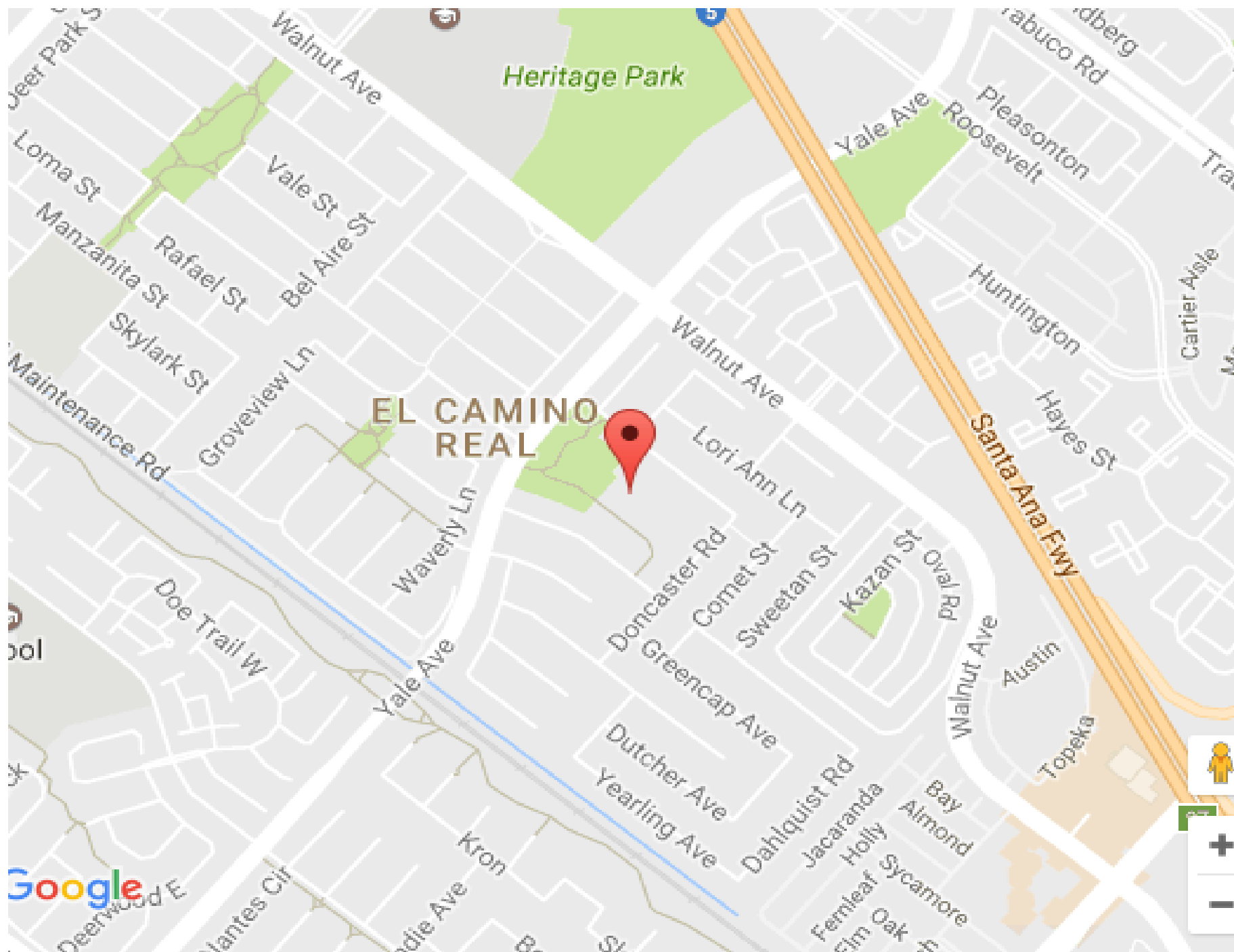
Timeframe for the Move

- Summer 2018 - Teachers and the school will move to El Camino
- August 2018 – Meadow Park students will attend school at El Camino(2018-2019 school year)
- Summer 2019 - Teachers and school will move back into Meadow Park
- August 2019 - Students will return to Meadow Park campus

El Camino Elementary?

- The District will make improvements to El Camino so that it will be ready for students in August 2018
- All students will be attending El Camino Elementary. Students will not be attending multiple school sites.
- Transportation will be provided. IUSD will determine the safest pick up / drop off zones
