Minutes:

- 1) Meeting called to order at 5:00 pm
- 2) Kristen Winn reviewed timeline December 2015 June 2016
- 3) Kristen Winn introduced a draft of the implementation timeline for 2016-2017
 - (a) June 2016 August 2016: IUSD revises opt out parent letter; review comprehensive sexual health materials form OCDE
 - (b) Sept December: *Positive Prevention Plus* training (OCDE); HAC approves sensitive materials and speakers (ongoing); Health PLC's; District leadership discusses where and when MS health will be taught; compliance survey for MS
 - (c) January March 2017: continue health training for teachers including summer school teachers; IUSD board approval of new curriculum;
 - (d) April June 2017: Finish revision of Health courses and common assessments (online and summer school course included); ongoing IUSD Professional Development for summer school Health teachers It is the goal of the STEM department to have all new criteria approved by the Health Advisory Committee and in place by June 2017 (prior to summer school health courses). <u>Currently there</u> is no language in the law as to when school districts are required to be compliant.
- 4) Lori Fallace- Review of AB 329 CA Healthy Youth Act: mandates that all schools in CA teach comprehensive sexual education once in middle school, and once in high school. New content to IUSD that will be in place in order to be compliant include:
 - a) recognizing sexual orientation, gender expressions and identify
 - b) medically accurate and up to date information on HIV and STI's
 - c) emergency contraception
 - d) parenting, adoption and abortion
 - e) sexual harassment, trafficking, abuse, etc. (some new to IUSD especially assault and trafficking)
 - f) opt out only
- 5) AB 625 yes means yes affirmative consent, many of our high schools are already teaching this
- 6) **AB 302** Lactation Areas schools must provide safe and private areas for women who are breastfeeding
- 7) AB 329 Compliance Evaluation High school Health teachers completed this prior to the May 24 PLC meeting. Areas of need:
 - a. Item 6 and 7 Accessible to EL and Learners with Disabilities—planned parenthood has a program that is accessible to EL and disabilities; we also have translators, OCDE has a module for SPED student, we also have a new comers class for health. EL health at Venado in new comer class

- b. Items 17-21: Unbiased, culturally inclusive materials on sexual orientation and same sex relationships; gender, gender expression, and gender identity
- c. Item 25: Sex Trafficking
- d. Item 28 opt out form- translated to multiple languages; can be online or through OneStop
- e. Item 31: Trained instructors; when was the last time our teachers were trained? Especially summer school teachers?
- 8) LF has ordered other preview materials for LBGTQ from ETR; the committee previewed the materials in anticipation of presenting them to the full HAC for approval in the Fall (not enough board appointees for a quorum).
