



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE IRVINE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVING TO
INCREASE STATUTORY SCHOOL FACILITY FEES IMPOSED ON NEW RESIDENTIAL AND
COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION PURSUANT TO EDUCATION CODE SECTION 17620
AND GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 65995**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Education ("Board") of the Irvine Unified School District ("School District") will hold a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting to be held on March 15, 2022 to allow for public comment prior to consideration of its reports titled "Residential Development School Fee Justification Study for Irvine Unified School District" and "Commercial/Industrial Development School Fee Justification Study for Irvine Unified School District" ("Fee Studies"), and consider adopting a resolution of the Board of the School District to increase Statutory School Facility Fees Imposed on New Residential and Commercial/Industrial Construction Pursuant to Education Code Section 17620 and Government Code Section 65995. The Fee Studies justifying such increases, which are incorporated herein by this reference, are on file at the School District's offices, located 5050 Barranca Parkway, Irvine, CA 92604 and are available for public review from March 4, 2022 through March 15, 2022.

The Public Hearing of the School District, to be held March 15, 2022 will begin at 6:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the District Administration Center, located at 5050 Barranca Parkway, Irvine, CA 92604. These matters will be considered at such time as this agenda item is considered by the Board of the School District.
