### Initial ELPAC Assessment - Health and Safety Protocols

#### Checking In

- Social distancing of 6 feet is required for all families.
- Only one parent/guardian per family should bring the child/children.
- Parent/Guardian and students must wear a face covering/mask. **Students without face covering/mask will be rescheduled.**
- The student's temperature will be taken by Health Clerk before the session. **Any sick children will be rescheduled to a later date for testing.**
- Parent/Guardian will electronically check-in student. Touchless scan of QR code can be used for check-in on your mobile device. If device not available a laptop will be available (hand sanitizer will be provided for before/after use).
- 2<sup>nd</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade: Once students are taken in for the assessment, parent/guardian will be asked to leave and will receive a telephone call when child has completed the assessment and is ready to be exited.
- TK – 1<sup>st</sup> grade: Parent should remain on site and wait for your student to complete the assessment. Please maintain 6 feet of social distancing from others.
- **All common areas will be thoroughly sanitized each day.**
- The play structures on the facility are not open to the public and should not be used by the children.

#### Testing Facilities/Equipment

- All students will use hand sanitizer before beginning assessment.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will have no more than 8 students per classroom for testing and during the 1:1 speaking assessment plastic sneeze guards will be used.
- TK - 1<sup>st</sup> grade students will have no more than 3 students per classroom and plastic sneeze guards will be used for conducting the 1:1 assessments.
- Students will be placed at least 6 feet apart.
- **All areas, equipment, and furniture will be thoroughly sanitized between students.**
- A sanitized pencil will be provided to each student and will go home with the student. Pencils will not be shared.

#### Staff Members

- All staff members will wear a face covering/mask and gloves (or will wash/sanitize hands before and after each student).
- All staff members will have their temperature checked before the start of their shift.
- Any staff members who are ill will be asked to stay at home.
