#### Minutes:

Assistant Superintendent of Business Services, John Fogarty, reviewed the 2019-20 First Interim Report, projecting a positive ending fund balance through 2021-22, based on current available financial information. He reviewed the near-term outlook and two scenarios: Long-Term Economic Growth and Long-Term Recession, provided by the Legislative Analyst's Office. He advised, the Long-Term Economic Growth scenario, forecasts economic growth through 2023-24, and would result in steady education funding. The Long-Term Recession scenario assumes a moderate recession beginning in 2021 with schools funded at Prop 98 minimum funding levels reduced by \$20 billion, based on current policies. As of July 2019, the United States has matched the longest economic expansion period in US history. He reviewed the potential long-term impact to IUSD of the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) leaving IUSD underfunded an average of \$1,770 per ADA (\$62.2 million per year) when compared to the statewide average.

Member Wallin suggested future presentations to indicate TBD for unknown salary increases, rather than N/A.
