## COVID-19 and Reopening In-Person Instruction Framework

California Department of Public Health (CDPH)
January 14, 2021

- CDPH developed the comprehensive framework to support school communities as they determined how to implement in-person instruction for the remainder of the 2020/2021 school year.
- Required schools that had already reopened for in-person instruction to post a <u>COVID-19 Safety Plan</u> on its internet website homepage by <u>February 1, 2021</u>.
- IUSD's COVID-19 Safety Plan was posted on January 28, 2021.



# Assembly Bill 86 Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant

- Signed by Governor Newsom on March 5, 2021
- The bill required local education agencies to post a completed <u>COVID-19 safety plan</u> on its internet website homepage.
- The COVID-19 safety plan consisted of two components:
   <u>COVID-19 Prevention Program</u> required by Cal-OSHA's emergency standards
   <u>COVID-19 School Guidance Checklist</u> approved by CDPH
- The COVID-19 safety plan must have been posted at least 5 days before offering in-person instruction.
- Since IUSD was already offering in-person instruction, the <u>February 1, 2021</u> timeline required in the CDPH COVID-19 and Reopening In-Person Instruction Framework was recognized.



### Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) III Fund

- Signed into law on March 11, 2021.
- Requires local education agencies to develop a plan to ensure safe in-person instruction and continuity of services and to review its plan every six (6) months.
- The Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan must be posted within 30 days of completing the ESSER III Grant Assurances.
- ESSER III requires local education agencies to seek <u>public comments</u> in the development of its plan.
- IUSD consistently throughout the 2020/2021 school year, starting in July 2020, obtained input from community stakeholders in the development of its return to in-person instruction plan.
- With the allocation of \$18.2M, the public hearing is to guarantee ESSER III compliance seeking public comments for the Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan.
