

California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP): Electronic Student Score Reports – Frequently Asked Questions

Why are we transitioning to electronic reporting?

Electronic score reports are more convenient, efficient, engaging, and accessible than paper reports. Parents will now be able to securely access current and historical student score reports by smartphone, tablet, or computer through the Aeries Parent Portal. Since we no longer have to print and mail score reports, families will have earlier access to student results. Electronic score reports are no longer limited to one sheet of paper, so they also provide an opportunity to deliver more dynamic and detailed information about a student's progress.

What if I don't have access to a desktop computer?

You can view your student's score report on any device connected to the internet, such as a computer, tablet, or smartphone. Log into the Aeries Parent Portal (my.iusd.org) on your device to view the report. If you are not able to view the report online, you can ask for a copy at the front office of your child's school.

Is my child's information secure if it's online?

Yes, the Student Score Reports are secure because they are accessed through Parent Portal, which requires a username and password to access.

Will I get scores faster?

Yes, you will be able to view your child's score report online earlier than in the past. In the past, Student Score Reports had to be printed and mailed, which caused a delay. This year, you can view the report online as soon as it is available.

Can I still get a paper copy?

Student Score Reports dating back three years will be available in the Parent Portal, so you can always go back and print them. You can also ask for a paper copy in the front office of your child's school.

Will the report be available in my home language?

The electronic Student Score Reports will be available in English, Spanish, Traditional Chinese, Vietnamese, and Filipino. In the future, they will be translated into other languages as well. Available score report languages are automatically set based on a student's reporting language settings in Aeries. We are unable to add/change a student's report language for this school year, but can make changes for future years.
