Session 7: Sexually Transmitted Infections	<ul> <li>Activity 7.2: Provide <u>IUSD Version of STI Information Sheet</u> instead</li> <li>Activity 7.5: Condom Demonstration         <ul> <li>MS students may participate in steps 1-3 only. Teachers should complete 4-6 as a class demo.</li> <li>STEP 1: Store condoms in a cool, dry place.</li> <li>STEP 2: Ask for consent.</li> <li>STEP 3: Check the package and expiration date.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Steps 4-8 shall be conducted as a <u>teacher demo</u>. The video version of the demonstration is not approved. Students may <u>not</u> perform Steps 4-8.         <ul> <li>STEP 4: Open the package with hands.</li> <li>STEP 5: Check the direction of the condom.</li> <li>STEP 6: Pinch the tip and roll down the base of an erect penis.</li> <li>STEP 7: Remove the condom.</li> <li>STEP 8: Tie a knot and throw it into the trash.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Your site may choose to demo steps 4-8 with or without a penis model.</li> <li>NO to any mention of adding two drops of lubricant to the inside or outside of the condom to increase sensation and comfort. First two helpful tips should be crossed out.</li> <li>NO to Activity 7.6: Insertive Condom Demonstration. Not approved.</li> <li>If using Additional Activity: Condom Steps Game remove the line about adding lubricant to condoms.
