### 1. Single Stream Recycling



All recyclable material needs to stay out of the landfill. Recyclable material goes into clearly designated blue or green bins supplied by M&O. The Green Teams with custodial assistance will take this material outside to the large **white** “Single Stream” recycling container. All cardboard should be broken down and placed into this container as well

### Fund Raising Opportunities

2. Recycled plastic bottles and aluminum cans are a great source of revenue for the “Green Teams”. Students, staff and parents can get involved in this fund raising activity. Holding recycling drives at your school can help increase community awareness and potentially increase the revenue coming back to the schools “Green” programs.



Plastic bottles and aluminum cans should be diverted from the waste and from the “single stream” recycling containers by providing a clearly designated container for just bottles and/or cans. These bins can be provided by M&O.

OR



Schools can request a CR&R container for bottles and cans to be stored in. Bottles and cans should be separated into clear trash bags, then placed into the CR&R container. When the container is full, contact the Sustainability Supervisor to arrange pick up. The revenue is given to the school site. The redemption is \$1.19/lb. for plastic and \$1.57/lb. for aluminum cans. A full bin can total anywhere from \$500 - \$1000.
