- Roll Call:** Attendance taken via sign-in sheet. Chris Weber announced and welcomed new board appointed member Marla Roque-Wylie.

- Approval of Minutes:** Approve the minutes of the November 27, 2018 meeting as presented. Passed with a motion by Tina Chiang and seconded by Naz Hamid
- Oral Communication:** An opportunity to speak to a topic not on agenda (3 minutes per person not to exceed 30 minutes total) – blue slip speakers:

Health Advisory Committee Business

Approval of Sensitive Materials – The committee reviewed and discussed previously distributed materials for middle school and high school health courses.

Grades 7-12

- **Teen Talk Adapted for All Abilities Summer Updates** – Discussed and approved upon motion by Naz Hamid with the following conditions: A recommendation that teachers define the term “catfishing;” clarify with teachers that the program is only to be used with students in grades 7-12; a recommendation to describe what behaviors are appropriate in the workplace and outside in the workplace in Section 6.3; the video in Section 6.4, “Be Firm,” is not approved due to the insensitivity with which students with special needs are represented. This was seconded by Tina Chiang. Approved by 3-0 vote.

Middle School

- **Videos from the summer updates to Teen Talk** – Discussed and approved four of 16 videos upon motion by Tina Chiang. This motion was seconded by Naz Hamid. Approved by a 3-0 vote.

Updates & Next Steps

- The Education Code related to opting out of specific sexual education lessons is **ED Code 51932 (b)**.
- UCI Wellness provided their HIV 101 presentation at University High School.
- Fifteen teachers received initial training in Teen Talk in October of 2018. The training was very well received.
- Lori Fallace presented at the OCDE on October 31, 2019, to 14 other Orange County districts on IUSD's implementation of AB329 and communication with parents.
