• Teen Talk Adapted for All Abilities Summer Updates — Discussed and approved upon motion by Naz Hamid with the following conditions: A recommendation that teachers define the term "catfishing;" clarify with teachers that the program is only to be used with students in grades 7-12; a recommendation to describe what behaviors are appropriate in the workplace and outside in the workplace in Section 6.3; the video in Section 6.4, "Be Firm," is not approved due to the insensitivity with which students with special needs are represented. This was seconded by Tina Chiang. Approved by 3-0 vote.

#### Middle School

• Videos from the summer updates to Teen Talk — Discussed and approved four of 16 videos upon motion by Tina Chiang. This motion was seconded by Naz Hamid. Approved by a 3-0 vote.
