NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Irvine Unified School District of Orange County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as "DISTRICT," will receive up to, but not later than, the above-stated bid deadline, sealed bids at the place identified above for the award of a contract for:

RENTAL OF: TEMPORARY FENCING & MISC. ITEMS BID NO. 2017/2018-2FA

The DISTRICT is soliciting bids for rental of temporary fencing and miscellaneous items that will be used for new construction and modernization projects.

BID DOCUMENTS will be made available on October 24, 2017 (as a download) at the following website: <https://iusd.org/about/departments/business-services/facilities-planning-construction-services/bidder-information>.

Bidders will be responsible for reproducing all documents related to this bid. All bids shall be made and presented on the forms provided in the bid documents.

Per the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR), **no contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5** [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. That would include a firm that subcontracts to perform services such as soils testing, surveying, and building/construction inspection, and anyone hired by the firm to perform those same services as an independent contractor. Please also note that Labor Code section 1725.5(a)(2)(A) requires workers' compensation coverage for any worker employed by a registered public works contractor unless that worker is separately registered with D.I.R. as a public works contractor.

As required by Section 1773 of the California Labor Code, the California Department of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rates of per diem wages for the locality in which the work is to be performed for the Project. It shall be mandatory to whom the contract is awarded to pay not less than the specified rates to all workers employed by them for the Project.

The successful bidder and any listed subcontractor(s) of this Project are subject to the oversight monitoring and enforcement of prevailing wage requirements by the D.I.R., Division of Labor Standards Enforcement. In accordance with the provisions of Business and Professions Code Section 7028.15 and Public Contract Code Section 3300, the DISTRICT requires that the bidder possess the proper license(s) at the time the bid is submitted. Any bidder not so licensed at the time of the bid opening will be rejected as nonresponsive.

It is each bidder's sole responsibility to ensure its bid is timely delivered and received at the location designated as specified above. Any bid received at the designated location after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids shall be returned to the bidder unopened.

No bidder may withdraw any bid for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the date set for the opening of the bids.

Time is of the essence. The DISTRICT reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive irregularities or informality in any bids or in the bidding process.
