The Prevention and Intervention department provides academic, behavioral and social-emotional supports for students at the elementary and secondary level.

DISTRICT-WIDE SUPPORT STAFF:

Intervention Psychologist

Intervention Psychologists provide support to all schools (elementary, middle, and high) as they develop their multitiered system of support (MTSS) framework. In addition, they support sites in implementing academic intervention programs throughout the district.

PBIS TOSA

PBIS TOSAs facilitate the implementation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports at each school site helping to build positive school climates. PBIS TOSAs also offer professional learning opportunities through coaching, training, and consultations with school site staff; district programs; and support to parent communities.

Irvine Family Resource Center Therapists

The IFRC therapists are licensed Marriage and Family Therapists and Social Workers who provide short-term, solution-focused counseling services for IUSD, K-12 students and families who may not have easy access to affordable mental health or family support services.

ELEMENTARY SUPPORT STAFF: (Please contact site directly)

Specialist: Elementary Resource Counseling

Counseling Specialist staff who provide short-term individual and group counseling for students, social-emotional strategies for teachers, parent consultations, staff and parent education, and resource linkage for families.

Guidance Paraprofessional: Elementary

Paraprofessional staff who provide small group and classroom social-emotional skills lessons, using an evidence-based curriculum at the elementary school level.

MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL SUPPORT STAFF:

Specialist: Mental Health/School Wellness


Wellness Coordinators provide short-term solution-focused counseling, case management services and crisis intervention services for children and families who are experiencing social-emotional and mental health challenges.

Guidance Paraprofessional: Secondary

Paraprofessional staff who provide solution-focused small group counseling sessions for students at the middle and high school levels where they receive support in areas such as goal setting, communication skills, self-esteem, stress and anger management, peer pressure, and LGBTIQ.
