dress shoes, optional tie

6th, 7th and 8th Grade Students:

Ladies: Dressy black with black socks/stockings and black shoes (**no beach sandals**). Skirts and dresses are to be knee length or longer.

Gentlemen: Black dress pants, white dress shirts, black socks and shoes, and a tie.

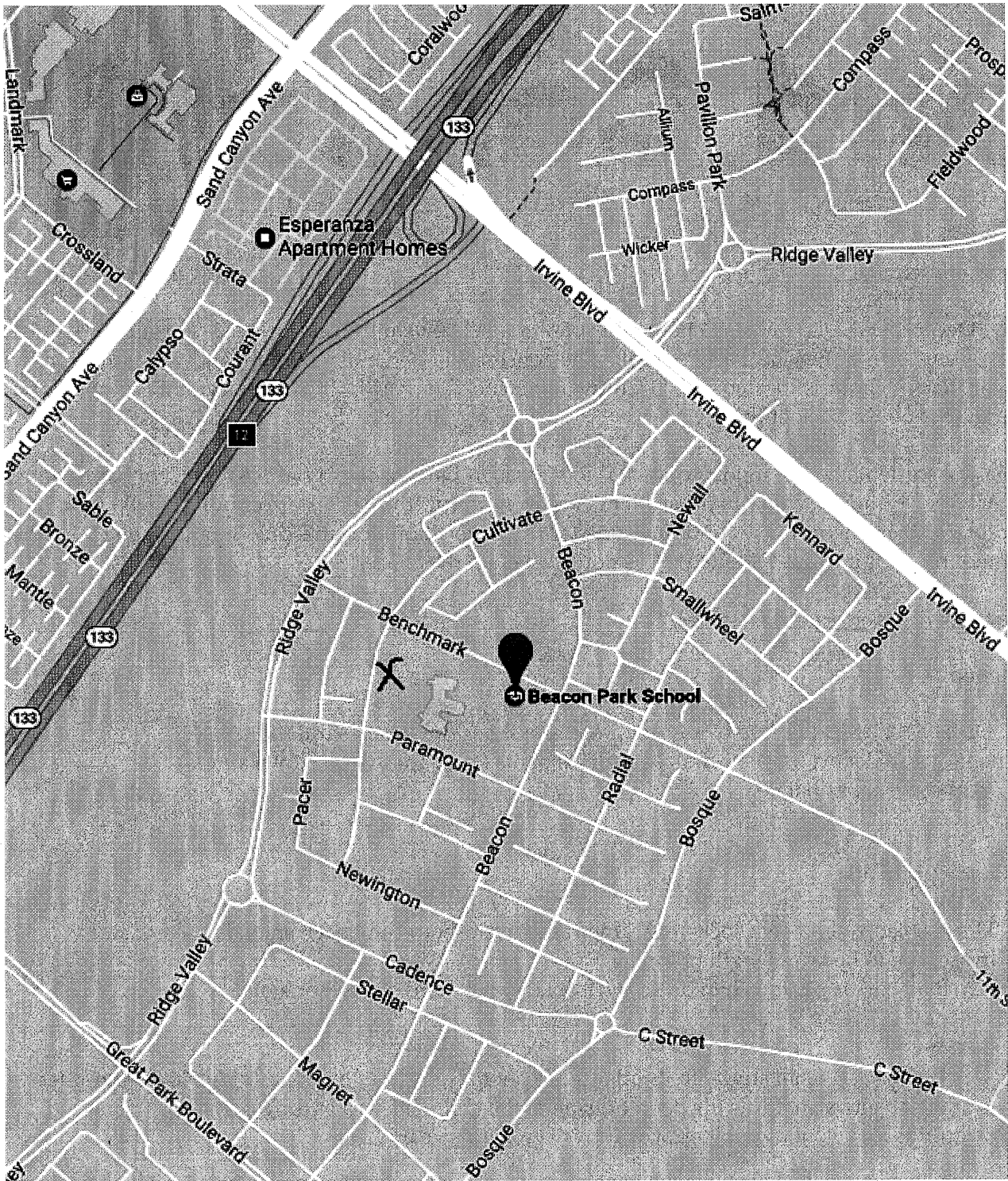
