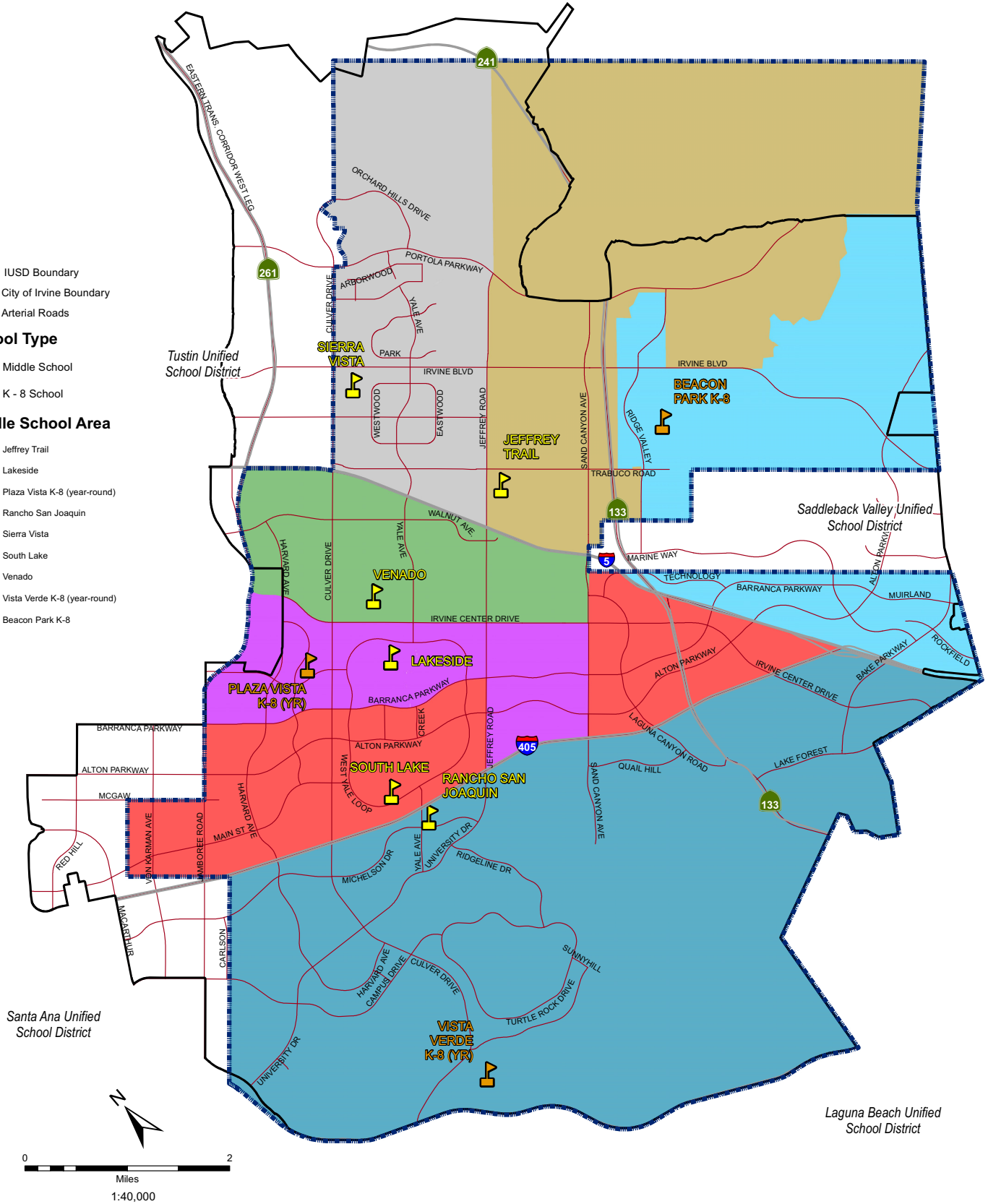

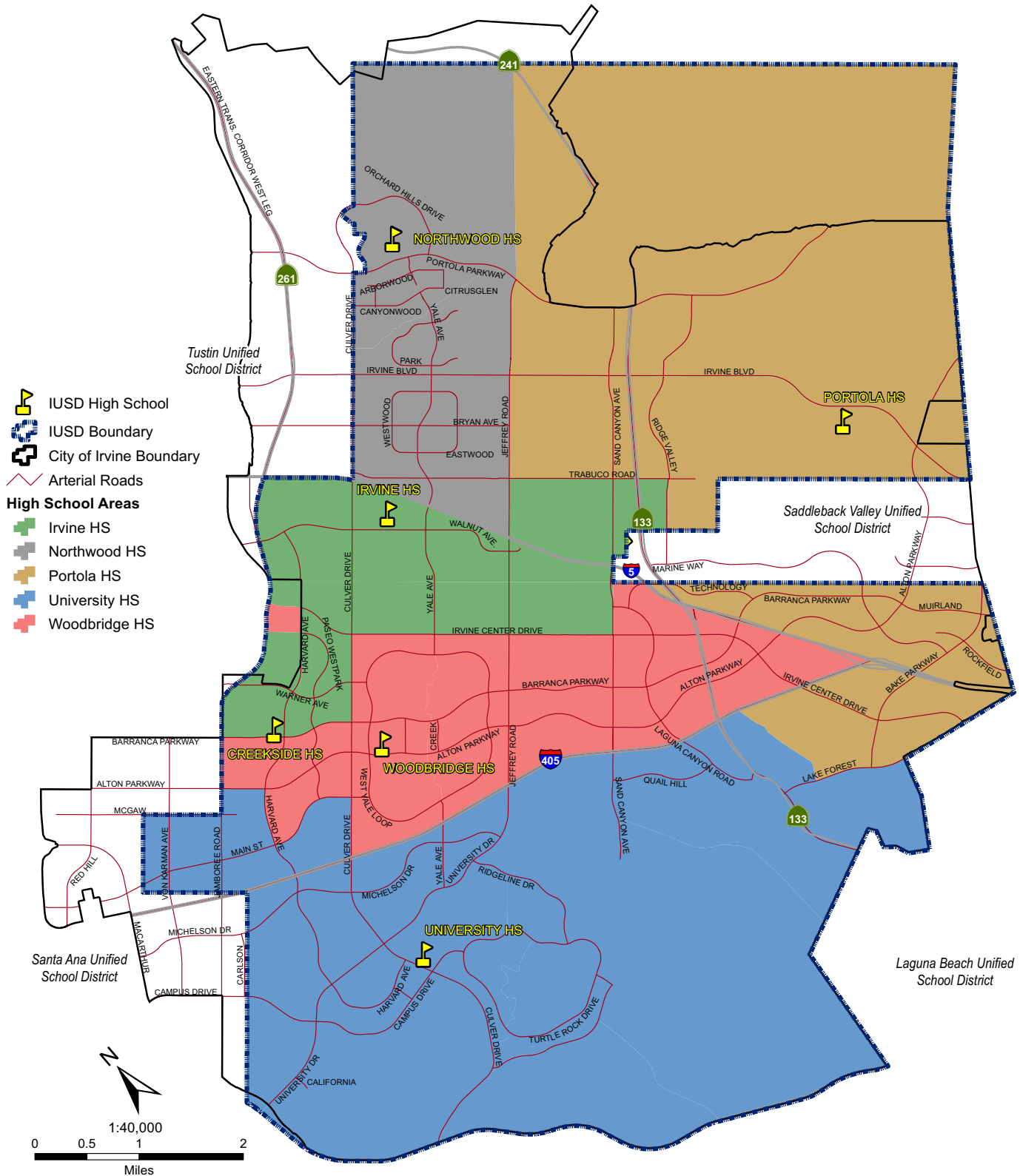

Fee-based enrichment classes are available to families interested in providing enrichment opportunities outside of the preschool day. On-going parent education opportunities are planned throughout the school year.
