

The Pitch Video Info

Video Details:

The *Pitch Video* is replacing the *Display Board*. Students must still complete an *Inventor's Notebook/Log* and a *Model/Prototype*. Their video should answer the same questions listed in the *Inventor's Notebook Key Points* (See full details on *Astounding Student Rule Sheet*).

Inventor's Notebook Key Points

- Student name and school
- Name of the invention
- What need or problem does the invention attempt to solve?
- How does the invention work and how was the invention made?
- What materials were used in its construction?
- What research did the student conduct to make sure their idea was new?
- Who helped the student with this invention?
- How does the invention help the environment?

The inventor may show the materials used, the prototype, how it works, and who helped them with the invention. The inventor's face does not need to appear in the video. The inventor is encouraged to draft an outline of what they want to say before recording the video. Students should speak clearly, loudly, and slowly, and be creative and get the viewer excited about their invention. We ask that videos be kept to about 2 minutes; videos may not be longer than 3 minutes long.

Video Submission

For IVC judging students DO NOT need to bring a device for the judge to view their video. All video submissions will be compiled into one folder for judges to view. IVC will be providing the technology need for this. Here are the ways students may submit their Video Pitch.

- Upload the video to YouTube, Google Drive, Dropbox, etc. Share the link with your AI site representative or directly to the STEM department at TracyEdstrom@iusd.org.
- Ensure that your video is set up to be viewed by anyone with the link.
- Email your video to your AI site representative or directly to the STEM department at TracyEdstrom@iusd.org. Files should be in the .mp4 format.

Video submission students must still come to the friday night check-in. Inventors will receive their name tag, IVC certificate, IVC t-shirt, and be given a spot on the gym floor to place their notebooks.
